Types of Bequests & Suggested Wordings:

1 Share of your estate (Residuary Bequest)

A Residuary Bequest provides for Parkerville Baptist to receive whatever is left of your estate or any size percentage that is left over from your estate, once your friends and family have been provided for.

Suggested wording:

I give to Parkerville Baptist Church Inc, 910 Seaborne Street, Parkerville WA 6081, the following ___ percent of OR the residue of my estate and declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper office for the time being shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executor for the said bequest.

2 Cash gift (Pecuniary Bequest)

A Pecuniary Bequest means leaving a gift of a set dollar amount of your choice.

Suggested wording:

I give to Parkerville Baptist Church Inc, 910 Seaborne Street, Parkerville WA 6081, the sum of \$_____ and declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper office for the time being shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executor for the said bequest.

How do I leave a bequest?

If you have already made a Will, no problem. You can simply make an amendment or addition to your Will, called a Codicil. The preparation of this must comply with the same legal requirements as needed to create your Will. See inside for suggested wordings.

If you don't already have a Will, then the suggested wordings inside can be incorporated in the document.

We suggest you create or update your existing Will using a solicitor or templates that are available from your local Post Office.
